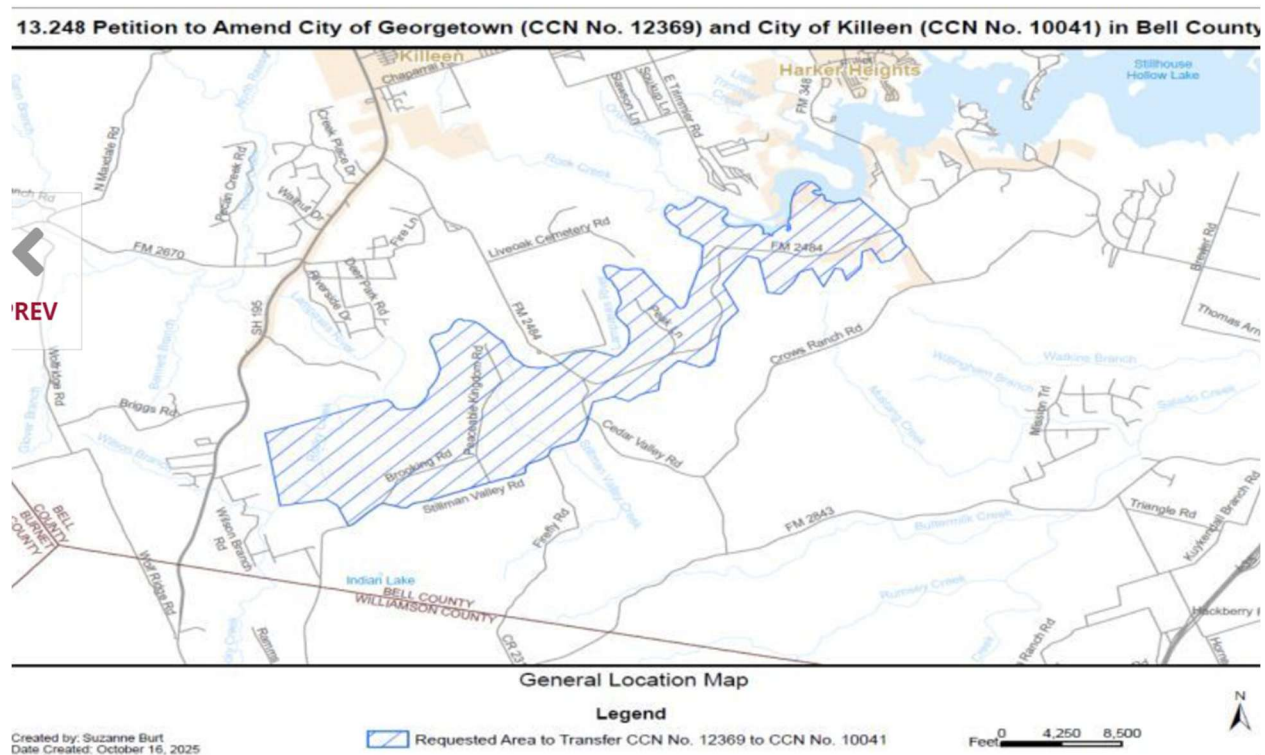


Purchase of CCNs “certificate of convenience and necessity” from Georgetown by Killeen

What it means plus timeline:

- Giving the city the exclusive rights to provide water as a retail utility. It does not give Killeen specific water rights
- Purchase area is 8,669 acres located in the city of Killeen’s extraterritorial jurisdiction south of the city near the border of Williamson County stretching toward Stillhouse Lake and Harker Heights.
- Will have 27.4 miles of pipe and 256 customers.



- Nov. 30, 2026: STM application filed with PUCT
- April 30, 2027: Transaction approval or hearing requested*
- May 31, 2027: Closing (if hearing is not requested)
- Nov. 30, 2027: CCN transfer final order
